### Dedication to Racing Award

#### Dedication to Racing Award:

For a long-serving member of staff, who is an integral part of the team, offers a wealth of industry experience and knowledge and a love and dedication of their job.

#### What are The Godolphin Stud and Stable Staff Awards?

The Stud and Stable Staff Awards were initiated in 2005 to recognise the achievements of racing's key staff. They are generously sponsored by Godolphin and are run by the British Horseracing Authority, in conjunction with the Racing Post. In further support of the Awards, Godolphin has also increased the prize fund in 2010 to £120,000.

#### Who can enter this category?

The competition is open to any candidate currently employed as Stud or Stable Staff within England, Wales or Scotland at the time of nomination. **Anyone from within the industry can nominate, so owners, trainers, breeders and other industry staff, including yard and travelling staff and office administrators, can nominate those who they feel deserve an award.**

Nominations for the Dedication to Racing Award are open to those who have dedicated long service to their profession, working for a minimum of 10 years within the industry.

#### Who will judge the award and on what criteria will the nominees be judged?

The judging panel will be made up of six influential racing figures, Chaired by Brough Scott. The Judges will be looking for someone who is a long-serving member of staff who is not only an integral part of the team, but also displays skills and attributes such as experience and knowledge of the industry, commitment to the business, love of the job and dedication.

#### What is the prize for this Award category?

The overall winner of the award will be awarded £5,000 and their yard will also receive £5,000. Two runners-up will also receive £2,000 each, as will their yards.
