## TRIPARTITE PROCESS

- Category A: Can be made by a 2:1 majority
  - Timetable and process for Fixture List compilation
  - Fixture List policy
  - Fixture List consultation
  - Overarching policy towards new racecourse applications
  - o Principles of the Field Size model
  - Definition of geographical clashes
- Category B: Must be made via unanimous agreement
  - Overall Industry strategy, including central funding mechanism (i.e. Levy or Levy replacement)
  - o Government Relations policy (Engagement led by BHA)
  - Horserace Betting Levy Board (HBLB) funding submissions and Racing's submission on the allocation of HBLB Funding
  - Draft form Prize Money Agreement (acknowledging that such agreements are negotiated between the BHA and the Horsemen with racecourses on an individual basis and not by the RCA on behalf of the racecourses)
  - o Racing Foundation –Trustee appointments
