#### **Online Apprentice Jockey Applications:**

As you will be aware, the BHA has introduced a new online licensing system. This system has been developed by Weatherbys on our behalf and aims to provide a modern, efficient and customer friendly administration system for all Licensed and Permitted individuals.

#### The Application Process:

Every application has to be considered individually upon its merits. In many cases correspondence is involved and in some cases, a personal interview is necessary. Therefore, please complete and submit the application in good time to allow the Team to deal with any queries.

In completing the online form, you are directed to the Guidance Notes which should be read in full. These are available online.

Applications for a new Apprentice Licence should be submitted at least 3 weeks prior to when they are required, to allow sufficient time for each application to be processed.

#### BHA Jockey Coaching Programme (JCP)

Once a Licence has been granted an Apprentice Jockey is entitled to be allocated a UKCC Level 3 Qualified Coach. The Apprentice will receive coaching in all aspects of their careers from technical support to motivation, confidence, fitness and communication skills. # **Apprentice Jockey User Guide:**

### <u>Making an online application for</u> <u>an Apprentice Jockey's Licence using the</u> <u>New Racing Administration System</u>

#### **INTRODUCTION**

The following document is a User Guide to assist you through the process of completing the new online licence application form for an Apprentice Jockey's Licence. There is a separate User Guide designed to assist the Trainer with completing their section of the application.

The Guide takes you through the process of completing an application for the first time and provides screen mock-ups and tips to assist you.

Further sections demonstrate how to use the system in the future, for example a change to your personal details, in this case your mobile phone number.

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#### **Accessing the Application Form**

The application form is made jointly between the Trainer, you as the Apprentice and your parent/guardian if you are under the age of 18.

The Trainer will start the application process off and once they have completed their section <u>you will</u> <u>receive an email</u> notifying you of this and providing instruction on how you can access your section of the application.

You will receive an email similar to the below:
