

## 30-DAY FOAL NOTIFICATION

## Whereabouts notification

When a foal is bred for racing in Great Britain the breeder/owner must notify the General Stud Book (Weatherbys) of its birth and whereabouts **within 30 days of its birth** (day 1 being the date of birth). Notification should be done through the online portal: <a href="https://www.weatherbysgsb.co.uk/">https://www.weatherbysgsb.co.uk/</a>.

Please be aware that foal notification is different from foal registration, which must still be completed with the General Stud Book in accordance with the legislative requirements and any other Rules of Racing.

## **CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE**

If notification has <u>not</u> been received within the 30-day window, before the horse may be eligible to race the BHA may require a certificate of analysis reporting no evidence of the presence or use of a substance/method prohibited at all times in a sample collected by the BHA.

A fee structure is in place to cover the cost of the testing. The fee increases on a sliding scale depending on how late the notification is. In exceptional circumstances, for example, where an individual or company continually fail to comply with the requirement, a foal may not be approved as eligible to run in Great Britain.
