

Whip Review Committee Decisions 17 January 2023

On Tuesday 17 January 2023 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards for races run from 9 January 2023 – 15 January 2023 inclusive. A summary of their findings are outlined below.

Ayr 09 January 2023

Race 1: The Racing TV EBF Mares' "National Hunt" Novices Hurdle (EBF Mares' NH Novices' Hurdle Qualifier) (CLASS 4).

Brian Hayes, the rider CHAMPAGNESOCIALIST (IRE), placed second, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip in the incorrect place on the run to the line.

Wetherby 14 January 2023

Race 6: The Racing TV Anywhere Handicap Chase (Go North Red Rum Series Qualifier) (CLASS 4)

Sean Bowen, the rider of the winner MACKELDUFF (FR), had used his whip without time to respond approaching the last fence. As the offence warranted a suspension between 2 and 6 days and considering this was to be Bowen's fifth suspension within the previous 6 months, Bowen was referred to the Judicial Panel.

Kelso 15 January 2023

Race 3: The racing.tv/freetrial Handicap Chase (Go North Monet's Garden Series Qualifier)(CLASS 4)

Sam Coltherd, the rider of FORTIFIED BAY (IRE), placed third, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip with his arm above shoulder height in the home straight.

Race 7: The Kelso Annual Membership Conditional Jockeys' Handicap Chase (Go North Red Rum Series Qualifier) (CLASS 5)

Thomas Willmott, the rider of the winner TO THE LIMIT (IRE), was suspended for 4 days for using his whip above the permitted level from the turn into the home straight.
